

Newcrest starts work near Leonora

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JINDALEE Resources will be an interested onlooker this week as partner Newcrest Mining begins drilling four 250m RC holes at the Irontank Well prospect in Western Australia's Eastern Goldfields.

Irontank Well, located some 30km east of Leonora, straddles the eastern margin of the Keith Kilkenny tectonic zone and is immediately southeast along strike from the Crawford prospect.

Previous drill results from Crawford include 16m at 3.07 grams per tonne from RAB drilling and 26m at 1.68gpt from RC drilling.

Newcrest and Golden State Resources can earn a 70% interest in the project by spending \$1 million in a four-year period.

The drilling at Irontank Well will test structural targets generated from a gravity survey, with drill results expected early next month.
